AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to prohibiting the approval of licenses for alcoholism programs, substance abuse programs, and chemical dependence programs within five hundred feet of a school, public park, or church, synagogue, or other place of worship

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 19.21 of the mental hygiene law, as added by chapter 223 of the laws of 1992, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The office shall inspect and approve or disapprove the facilities
of and the services provided by alcoholism programs, substance abuse
programs, and chemical dependence programs, and any program or facility
purporting to provide such services. The office shall not approve any
facility of or services provided by any alcoholism program, substance
abuse program, or chemical dependence program, or any program or facility purporting to provide such services where such facility is, or where
the location of such services are, located within five hundred feet of a
school, public park, or church, synagogue, or other place of worship.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
