AN ACT to amend the general municipal law and the town law, in relation to authorizing fees and charges for emergency medical services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 209-b of the general municipal 2 law, as amended by chapter 476 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4. Fees and charges [prohibited] authorized. [Emergency] (a) Subject 4 5 to the restrictions set forth in paragraph (d) of this subdivision, emergency and general ambulance service, including emergency medical б 7 service as defined in section three thousand one of the public health law, authorized pursuant to this section [shall] may be furnished with-8 9 out cost to the person served; provided, however, that the authorities 10 having control of a fire department or fire company that have authorized such fire department or fire company to provide such service or services 11 12 may fix a schedule of fees or charges to be paid by persons requesting 13 such service or services. The authorities having control of a fire department or fire company may provide for the collection of fees and 14

charges or may formulate rules and regulations for the collection there-1 of by the fire department or fire company. When fees and charges are 2 authorized pursuant to this subdivision, the fees and charges collected 3 4 shall be disbursed in accordance with a written contract entered into 5 between the authority having control of a fire department or fire compa-The acceptance by б ny and the fire department or fire company itself. 7 any firefighter of any personal remuneration or gratuity, directly or 8 indirectly, from a person served shall be a ground for his or her expul-9 sion or suspension as a member of the fire department or fire company. 10 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) of this subdivi-11 sion, a basic life support service which establishes a schedule of fees 12 for service shall enter into a contract with a provider or providers of 13 advanced life support services to provide such advanced life support 14 services. Such contract shall at a minimum establish the fees for advanced life support services and the means by which said provider will 15 16 be reimbursed when the ambulance service bills for emergency medical 17 service. (c) An emergency and general ambulance service, including emergency 18 19 medical service as defined in section three thousand one of the public 20 health law, authorized pursuant to this section which does not issue a 21 bill for its services and which requests an Advanced Life Support (ALS) intercept from another ambulance service furnishing service in an area 22 that is designated as a rural area by any law or regulation of the 23 state, or that is located in a rural census tract of a metropolitan 24 25 statistical area (as determined under the most recent Goldsmith Modifi-26 cation), shall pay the ambulance service providing the ALS intercept an 27 ALS Rural Intercept Fee at rates negotiated between the providers of such services. In the absence of any agreed upon rates, the service 28 29 receiving such ALS intercept shall pay the service providing the ALS 30 intercept for such services at the usual and customary charge, which 31 shall not be excessive or unreasonable. 32 (d) An emergency and general ambulance service, including emergency 33 medical service as defined in section three thousand one of the public health law, authorized pursuant to this section to fix a schedule of 34 35 fees or charges to be paid by persons requesting such service or 36 services, may apply such fees and charges only within such service's 37 primary response territory as assigned and evidenced by a valid ambu-38 lance service certificate issued by the commissioner of health pursuant 39 to section three thousand five of the public health law, on or before 40 January first, two thousand twenty-one. 41 (e) An emergency and general ambulance service, including emergency 42 medical service as defined in section three thousand one of the public 43 health law, authorized pursuant to this section shall not directly issue 44 a bill for its services to any uninsured recipient of such services. 45 § 2. Paragraph (e) of subdivision 1 of section 122-b of the general 46 municipal law, as amended by chapter 303 of the laws of 1980, is amended 47 to read as follows: 48 (e) [No] A contract [shall] may be entered into pursuant to the provisions of this section for the services of an emergency rescue and 49 50 first aid squad of a fire department or fire company which is subject to 51 the provisions of section two hundred nine-b of [the general municipal 52 **law**] this chapter; 53 § 3. Subdivision 1 of section 184 of the town law, as amended by chap-54 ter 599 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows: 55 1. Whenever the town board shall have established or extended a fire 56 protection district pursuant to the provisions of this article, the town

1 board shall provide for the furnishing of fire protection within the district and for that purpose may (a) contract with any city, village, 2 fire district or incorporated fire company maintaining adequate and 3 suitable apparatus and appliances for the furnishing of fire protection 4 5 in such district or (b) may acquire by gift or purchase such apparatus б and appliances for use in such district and may contract with any city, 7 village, fire district or incorporated fire company for operation, main-8 tenance, and repair of the same and for the furnishing of fire 9 protection in such district, or both. The contract may also provide for 10 the furnishing of (1) emergency service in case of accidents, calamities 11 or other emergencies in connection with which the services of firefighters would be required and (2) general ambulance service subject, howev-12 er, to the provisions of section two hundred nine-b of the general 13 14 municipal law. In the event that the fire department or fire company 15 furnishing fire protection within the district pursuant to contract does 16 not maintain and operate an ambulance then a separate contract may be made for the furnishing within the district of emergency ambulance 17 service or general ambulance service, or both, with any city, village or 18 fire district the fire department of which, or with an incorporated fire 19 20 company having its headquarters outside the district which, maintains 21 and operates an ambulance subject, however, in the case of general ambu-22 lance service, to the provisions of section two hundred nine-b of the 23 general municipal law, or with an ambulance service, certified or regis-24 tered pursuant to article thirty of the public health law[, which is not 25 organized under the provisions of section two hundred nine-b of the 26 general municipal law]. Any such contract with any such ambulance 27 service permitted herein shall be subject to the provisions of this 28 section. 29 § 4. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 30 have become a law and shall apply to health care claims submitted on or

31 after such date.
