AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to enacting the "child care provider direct deposit act"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 the "child care provider direct deposit act".

- 3 § 2. Section 390-c of the social services law, as added by chapter 460 4 of the laws of 2000, is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as 5 follows:
- 4. The commissioner of children and family services is authorized and 6 7 directed, no later than one year from the effective date of this subdivision, to promulgate rules and regulations to require that local social 9 services districts offer child day care providers, as defined in section 10 three hundred ninety of this title, the option to be paid any monies 11 owed for providing subsidized child care by a deposit directly into a 12 bank account of the child day care provider. Such direct deposit shall 13 only be made at the express written consent of the provider and shall be 14 requested on forms provided by the local social services district, and 15 duly filled in. Such written request may be revoked at any time by the 16 provider in writing on forms provided by the local social services 17 district.
- 18 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
