AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as "Specialist Gerald B. Penn Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-m to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-m. Portion of the state highway system to be designated and 4 known as the "Specialist Gerald B. Penn Memorial Bridge". All that portion of the state highway system constituting the bridge on route two hundred nineteen, designated bridge number 10416650, which crosses the Eighteen Mile Creek six-tenths of a mile north of the junction of routes three hundred ninety-one and two hundred nineteen, in the town of 9 Hamburg, county of Erie, shall be known as the "Specialist Gerald B. 10 Penn Memorial Bridge".

§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-11 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 13 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 14 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-15 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 16 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be changed as a result of this act. 17 18

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
