AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to authorizing the village of Perry, county of Wyoming to hire a planning board member, zoning board of appeals member or zoning officer who are not residents of such village

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new
2	subdivision 31 to read as follows:
3	31. Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter or any other chap-
4	ter, general law, local law, ordinance, or special act, the village
5	board of trustees of the incorporated village of Perry, Wyoming county,
6	may, by resolution, provide that a planning board member, zoning board
7	of appeals member or zoning officer of the village of Perry, Wyoming
8	county, need not be a resident of such village, but must be a resident
9	of the county in which such village is located or an adjoining county
10	within the state of New York.
11	§ 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new
12	subdivision 71 to read as follows:
13	71. In the village of Perry, in the county of Wyoming, the provisions
14	of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political
15	subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she
16	shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are
17	required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the
18	office of planning board member, zoning board of appeals member or
19	zoning officer of the village of Perry, provided that such person
20	resides in the county in which such village is located or an adjoining
21	county within the state of New York. Provided, however, the person
22	performing the functions of planning board member, zoning board of
23	appeals member or zoning officer in any other village shall be a resi-
24	dent of such village, unless otherwise provided by law.
25	§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
