AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to a veteran health care navigator program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 361-a 2 to read as follows:
- § 361-a. Veteran health care navigator program. 1. The division shall undertake a study regarding development and implementation of a veteran health care navigator program as provided in this section. Such study shall be completed and reported to the legislature on or before December thirty-first, two thousand twenty-two.
- 2. The veteran health care navigator program shall employ an adequate number of veteran health care navigators. Navigators shall be defined as full-time employees of the division who have direct knowledge of the veteran communities they serve. Their role shall include efforts to:
- 12 <u>(a) increase access by veterans and their families to health care</u>
  13 <u>coverage and services;</u>
- 14 (b) leverage existing resources and structures in areas where veterans
  15 and their families are able to easily access such resources;
- 16 <u>(c) ensure the needs of veterans and their families are incorporated</u>
  17 <u>in all state efforts to expand access to affordable, quality health</u>
  18 <u>care; and</u>
- 19 <u>(d) ensure veterans and their families have access to mental health</u>
  20 <u>treatment, including for post-traumatic stress disorder, depression, and</u>
  21 suicide prevention.
- 22 <u>3. The program, when implemented, shall provide the following duties</u>
  23 <u>for veteran health care navigators:</u>
- 24 (a) identifying all federal and other health benefits, coverage, and 25 services available to veterans and their families;

(b) coordinating with other local, state, and federal departments and agencies, health care providers, and health insurance programs to help veterans and their beneficiaries apply for coverage under such programs, including helping veterans overcome barriers within the health care system, to ensure enrollment in health plans and effective delivery and coordination of health services;

- (c) ensuring that access to mental health coverage, services, and treatment is a primary focus of their activities under the program;
- 9 <u>(d) connecting veterans to trained mental health care providers,</u>
  10 <u>including those trained in veteran suicide prevention; and</u>
- 11 (e) carrying out such other duties as the state director may assign 12 under the program.
- 4. Upon implementation of the program under this section, when carrying out their duties under the program, the division and the veteran
  health care navigators shall coordinate and collaborate with other relevant local, state and federal departments and agencies, including, but
  not limited to state and local veteran's service agencies and local
  veterans' committees, and the U.S. department of health and human
  services.
- 5. As part of the study, the division shall also, in consultation with the federal department of health and human services, conduct an examination of all existing health care and veterans' programs to:
- 23 <u>(a) evaluate whether the needs of veterans and their families are met</u> 24 <u>by such programs;</u>
- 25 (b) determine any necessary and appropriate steps that could be taken
  26 to increase access to affordable, quality health care, including by rule
  27 and regulation pursuant to existing statutory authority, or through new
  28 legislation; and
- 29 <u>(c) evaluate how the veteran health care navigator program proposed</u>
  30 <u>under this section could improve access to affordable, quality health</u>
  31 <u>care for veterans and their families.</u>
- 32 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
