AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Samuel Trombley Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-m to
2 read as follows:

3 § 344-m. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the
4 "Samuel Trombley Bridge". The bridge at the intersection of state route
5 eleven and state route one hundred ninety, designated bridge number
6 1039640 971LX, which crosses over the north branch of the Great Chazy
7 River, in the town of Ellenburg, county of Clinton, shall be designated
8 and known as the "Samuel Trombley Bridge".

9 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-
10 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system
11 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid
12 confusion and to limit any possible disruption to commerce, the desig-
13 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of a
14 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be
15 changed as a result of this act.

16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
