CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to section 24 of article 6 of the constitution, in relation to allowing an impeachment proceeding to proceed after the resignation of a person from public office and prohibits such person from holding a future public office

Section 1. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That section 24 of article 6 of the constitution be amended to read as follows:

§ 24. The assembly shall have the power of impeachment by a vote of a majority of all the members elected thereto. The court for the trial of impeachments shall be composed of the president of the senate, the senators, or the major part of them, and the judges of the court of appeals, or the major part of them. Impeachment and a trial of impeachments may proceed against a person who has resigned from any public 9 office of honor, trust, or profit under this state. On the trial of an impeachment against the governor or lieutenant-governor, neither the 10 11 lieutenant-governor nor the temporary president of the senate shall act as a member of the court. No judicial officer shall exercise his or her 12 office after articles of impeachment against him or her shall have been 13 preferred to the senate, until he or she shall have been acquitted. Before the trial of an impeachment, the members of the court shall take an oath or affirmation truly and impartially to try the impeachment 16 according to the evidence, and no person shall be convicted without the 17 concurrence of two-thirds of the members present. Judgment in cases of 18 impeachment shall not extend further than to removal from office, or 19 20 removal from office and disqualification to hold and enjoy any public 21 office of honor, trust, or profit under this state, or disqualification 22 to hold and enjoy any public office of honor, trust, or profit under 23 this state where a person has resigned such public office before such judgment is rendered; but the party impeached shall be liable to indict-25 ment and punishment according to law.
