AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to requiring the department of agriculture and markets to develop and maintain a directory of New York state farms and farm products

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 52 of section 16 of the agriculture and markets law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the agriculture and markets law relating to requiring the department of agriculture and markets to develop and maintain a database of New York state farms and farm products, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 6330-A and A. 7403-A, is amended to read as follows:

52. Develop and maintain[- in cooperation with the department of economic development and urban development corporation, a publicly available searchable [database] directory of New York state farms and farm products on the department's website. The [database] website directory shall include all farms located within the state and shall, 12 when known, list the products available for purchase and contact infor-13 mation for each farm, unless a farm opts out of being included in the [database] directory by notifying the department of such option. The 15 department shall [provide easily accessible electronic access 16 database on the department's website and shall update the [database] website directory at least every two years.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the agriculture and 19 markets law relating to requiring the department of agriculture and 21 markets to develop and maintain a database of New York state farms and 22 farm products, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 6330-A and A. 7403-A, takes effect.
