AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to zero-emissions for trains

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The section heading and subdivision 1 of section 19-0306-b of the environmental conservation law, as added by chapter 423 of the laws of 2021, are amended to read as follows:

Zero-emissions cars [and], trucks and trains.

- 1. It shall be a goal of the state that one hundred percent of new passenger cars and trucks offered for sale or lease, or sold, or leased, for registration in the state shall be zero-emissions by two thousand thirty-five. It shall be a further goal of the state that one hundred percent of trains purchased by the state or any public authority thereof for commuter rail service as defined in paragraph a of subdivision one of section ninety-seven-a of the railroad law, be zero-emissions by two thousand thirty-five. It shall be a further goal of the state that one hundred percent of medium-duty and heavy-duty vehicles offered for sale or lease, or sold, or leased, for registration in the state be zero-emissions by two thousand forty-five for all operations where feasible. It shall be further a goal of the state to transition to one hundred percent zero-emissions off-road vehicles and equipment by two thousand thirty-five where feasible.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
