AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the unlawful discharge of a loaded firearm toward any police officer, firefighter, corrections officer, peace officer, or emergency medical services personnel

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 265.35 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 4 to read as follows:

4. Any person who willfully discharges a loaded firearm or any other
gun, the propelling force of which is gunpowder, while pointed or aimed
at a peace officer, police officer, corrections officer, firefighter or
emergency medical services professional, with or without malice, is
quilty of a class B felony.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 9 have become a law.
