AN ACT to amend the public authorities law and the criminal procedure law, in relation to authorizing the Syracuse regional airport authority to designate certain employees as peace officers

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2799-qqq of the public authorities law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 12-a to read as follows:

12-a. to appoint or designate one or more persons for the purpose of 4 enforcing rules and regulations established by the authority, and to 5 compel the observance of law and order on the properties and facilities 6 of the authority for the protection and administration of such properties and facilities. Each person as and when so appointed or designated shall be known as a "Syracuse regional airport authority security officer" and shall be a peace officer as set forth in subdivision eighty-six 10 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law, or a police officer if so 11 designated by the authority in accordance with paragraph (e) of subdivi-12 sion thirty-four of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law;

- § 2. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by adding a 13 14 new subdivision 86 to read as follows:
- 15 86. Security officers appointed and designated as peace officers by 16 the Syracuse regional airport authority, pursuant to subdivision 17 twelve-a of section twenty-seven hundred ninety-nine-ggg of the public 18 authorities law; provided, however, that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to authorize such officer to carry, possess, repair or
- 19 20 <u>dispose of a firearm unless the appropriate license therefor has been</u>
- 21 issued pursuant to section 400.00 of the penal law.
- 22 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
