**WHEREAS,** There is a vacancy existing in the membership of this House, which was filled at the election held on May 24, 2022; and

**WHEREAS,** The final official canvass of the votes cast at said election and certification thereof of the person elected thereat, cannot be made at this time; and

**WHEREAS,** The Board of Elections of the City of New York has advised that the votes cast for the Office of Member of Assembly in the 58th Assembly District in the County of Kings shown by its canvass were respectively as follows: Monique Chandler-Waterman, Democrat and Working Families, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six; Monique Allen-Davy, Republican and Conservative, fifty-five; Hercules E. Reid, Education is Key, four hundred and thirty-one; and

**WHEREAS,** It appears that the results of the votes cast in said Assembly District cannot be affected by the final official canvass of such voters; and

**WHEREAS,** Monique Chandler-Waterman has duly taken an oath of office as a Member of Assembly; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That Monique Chandler-Waterman, Democrat and Working Families, is duly elected and qualified as a Member of the Assembly for her respective district and that she be seated in this House as such Member.
