WHEREAS, Born in New York, on May 17, 1925, to Esther and Samuel Sweetbaum, Marshall David Sweetbaum proudly served his country during the Second World War before earning a degree from both Queens College and Fordham University School of Law; and

WHEREAS, Marshall David Sweetbaum went on to have a long and distinguished career as a practicing attorney for 70 years; and

WHEREAS, While he was passionate about many things, above all his greatest passion was being a father to his son, Joel, and a grandfather to his granddaughter, Tracy; he was also a beloved husband, brother, uncle, father-in-law, cousin and friend; and

WHEREAS, In addition to his son and granddaughter, Marshall David Sweetbaum is survived by his brother and sister-in-law, Harvey and Selma Sweetbaum; and

WHEREAS, Marshall David Sweetbaum's infinite selflessness and benevolence will shine on through his family's vivid and happy memories; his insight and strength will forever serve as a beacon of love, light and hope to the countless lives he touched; and

WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of compassion, Marshall David Sweetbaum leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all who were privileged to have known and loved such an amazing man; he will be deeply missed and truly merits the grateful tribute of this Legislative Body; now, therefore, be it
