- AN ACT to amend the county law and the executive law, in relation to the reporting of a veteran's suicide

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 677 of the county law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 10 to read as follows:

3 10. The coroner, coroner's physician or medical examiner shall prompt-4 ly report to the division of veterans' services, in a one page form 5 developed and provided by such division, any death which appears to be a 6 suicide by a person who, to the knowledge of the coroner, coroner's 7 physician or medical examiner, is a veteran.

8 § 2. Section 353 of the executive law is amended by adding a new 9 subdivision 26 to read as follows:

10 <u>26. To develop a one page form by which a coroner, coroner's physician</u> 11 <u>or medical examiner shall fill out to report to the division any death</u> 12 <u>which appears to be a suicide by a person who, to the knowledge of the</u> 13 <u>coroner, coroner's physician or medical examiner, is a veteran. This</u> 14 <u>form shall provide the address to which the form is to be mailed or</u> 15 <u>submitted electronically.</u>

§ 3. Within 60 days of the effective date of this act, the division of veterans' services shall establish and implement the procedures and forms necessary for the implementation of this act.

19 § 4. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 20 have become a law.
