AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to counting of affidavit ballots

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 7 of section 9-209 of the election law, as added by chapter 763 of the laws of 2021, is amended to 3 read as follows:
- 4 (d) If the central board of canvassers determines that a person was
 5 entitled to vote at such election, the board shall cast and canvass such
 6 affidavit ballot if such board finds that the voter appeared at [the
 7 correct] a polling place, in the correct county, regardless of the fact
 8 that the voter may have appeared in the incorrect election district,
 9 provided that such vote shall not be cast and canvassed for such
 10 contests for which the person was not entitled to vote at such election,
 11 and regardless of whether the voter's name was in the registration poll
 12 record.
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 14 it shall have become a law.
