AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to providing grants related to the expansion and support of crisis intervention services and diversion programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs (d) and (e) of subdivision 6 of section 186-f of  
2 the tax law, paragraph (d) as amended and paragraph (e) as added by  
3 section 39 of part B of chapter 56 of the laws of 2010, are amended and  
4 a new paragraph (f) is added to read as follows:

5 (d) To provide the costs of debt service for bonds and notes issued to  
6 finance expedited deployment funding pursuant to the provisions of  
7 section three hundred thirty-three of the county law and section sixteen  
8 hundred eighty-nine-h of the public authorities law; [~~and~~]

9 (e) [~~services~~] Services and expenses that support the [~~operations—and~~  
10 ~~mission—of~~] interoperable communications program within the division of  
11 homeland security and emergency services as appropriated by the legisla-  
12 ture[~~-~~];

13 (f) The sum of ten million dollars annually shall be used for the  
14 provision of grants related to the expansion and support of crisis  
15 intervention services and diversion programs as developed or approved by  
16 the New York state office of mental health, in conjunction with the  
17 division of criminal justice services for law enforcement officers, 911  
18 dispatchers or call takers, and first responders, to be distributed  
19 pursuant to a plan developed by the commissioner of the office of mental  
20 health and the commissioner of the division of criminal justice  
21 services. Such plan shall consider factors such as population and number  
22 of staff eligible for such training. The commissioner of the office of  
23 mental health and the commissioner of the division of criminal justice  
24 services shall provide a report to the governor and the legislature

2 to, information detailing the number of individuals trained, the occupa-
