AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to benefits of shared work programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 607 of the labor law, as amended 2 by section 23 of part 0 of chapter 57 of the laws of 2013, is amended to 3 read as follows:

- 1. Amount. An eligible claimant shall be paid benefits for any week equal to his or her benefit rate multiplied by the percentage of reduction of his or her wages resulting from reduced hours of work, but only if such percentage is no less than twenty percent. The weekly benefit amount shall be rounded off to the nearest dollar. A claimant shall not be paid such benefits in excess of twenty-six [weeks] times the amount of regular compensation (including dependents' allowances) payable to such individual for a week of total unemployment during a benefit year.
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
