AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to authorizing the village of Perry, county of Wyoming to hire a village clerk and deputy clerk who is not a resident of such village

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new
2 subdivision 31 to read as follows:

3 31. Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter or any other chap-
4 ter, general law, local law, ordinance, or special act, the village
5 board of trustees of the incorporated village of Perry, Wyoming county,
6 may, by resolution, provide that the village clerk and deputy clerk of
7 the village of Perry, Wyoming county, need not be a resident of such
8 village, but must be a resident of the county in which such village is
9 located or an adjoining county within the state of New York.

10 § 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new
11 subdivision 71 to read as follows:

12 71. In the village of Perry, in the county of Wyoming, the provisions
13 of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political
14 subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she
15 shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are
16 required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the
17 office of village clerk or deputy clerk of the village of Perry,
18 provided that such person resides in the county in which such village is
19 located or an adjoining county within the state of New York. Provided,
20 however, the person performing the functions of village clerk or deputy
21 clerk in any other village shall be a resident of such village, unless
22 otherwise provided by law.

23 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
