- AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to discrimination against vaccinated persons

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. The civil rights law is amended by adding a new section 40-h to read as follows: <u>§ 40-h. Discrimination against vaccinated persons. A person who</u>

4 <u>excludes from the equal enjoyment of any accommodation, facility or</u> 5 <u>privilege furnished by innkeepers or common carriers, amusement or</u> 6 <u>resort, any person because the person received a vaccination, is guilty</u>

- 7 <u>of a misdemeanor.</u>
- 8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
