AN ACT to amend chapter 387 of the laws of 2013 relating to including the trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the town of Southampton, trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the town of East Hampton and the trustees of Freeholders and Commonalty of the town of Southold as municipal corporations for the purposes of section 72-h of the general municipal law, in relation to extending the expiration of such provisions

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 3 of chapter 387 of the laws of 2013, relating to including the trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the town of Southampton, trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the town of East Hampton and the trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the town of Southold as municipal corporations for the purposes of section 72-h of the general municipal law, as amended by chapter 128 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that section one 9 of this act shall expire and be deemed repealed July 31, [2021] 2023.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
