AN ACT in relation to renaming the 149th Street Grand Concourse subway station the "149th Street-Hostos station"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Upon a determination by the Metropolitan Transportation Authority or the New York City Transit Authority that sufficient funds have been committed to it specifically for such purpose, the Metropolitan Transportation Authority, the public benefit corporation created by section 1263 of the public authorities law, and the New York City Transit Authority, the public benefit corporation created by section 1201 of the public authorities law, shall use such specifically committed funds to rename the 149th Street Grand Concourse subway station shared by the IRT Jerome Avenue line and the IRT White Plains Road line of the New York city subway to the 149th Street-Hostos station. The MTA shall ensure that all signs and any other items issued by the MTA are updated to accurately reflect the new name of the station within ten months.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
