AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to requiring certain insurers to provide coverage for tattooing performed by a physician as part of breast reconstruction surgery

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 20 of subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (A-1) to read as follows:

(A-1) Every policy providing coverage as required by subparagraph (A) of this paragraph shall also provide coverage for the tattooing of the nipple-areolar complex pursuant to or as part of such reconstruction if such tattooing is performed by a licensed physician working within their scope of practice.

§ 2. Paragraph 10 of subsection (k) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (A-1) to read as follows:

(A-1) Every group or blanket policy providing coverage as required by subparagraph (A) of this paragraph shall also provide coverage for the tattooing of the nipple-areolar complex pursuant to or as part of such reconstruction if such tattooing is performed by a licensed physician working within their scope of practice.

§ 3. Subsection (x) of section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 1-A to read as follows:

(1-A) Every contract providing coverage as required by paragraph one of this subsection shall also provide coverage for the tattooing of the nipple-areolar complex pursuant to or as part of such reconstruction if such tattooing is performed by a licensed physician working within their scope of practice.
