AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to requiring the commissioner of transportation to provide a report on collisions that have occurred between motor vehicles and bridges or elevated structures on or crossing highways

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 10 of the highway law is amended by adding a new subdivision 18-a to read as follows:

18-a. Include, in addition to the requirements of subdivision eighteen of this section, in his or her annual report to the legislature a statement of the number of motor vehicle collisions with bridges and elevated structures on or crossing highways under the jurisdiction of the department, the location of such collisions, the condition of bridges and elevated structures under the jurisdiction of the department following such collisions, the progress of the department in reducing or eliminating the occurrence of such collisions, the amount of moneys received and expended by the department during the fiscal year to reduce and eliminate such collisions, the economic cost of such collisions, and the department's recommendations in relation to reducing and eliminating such motor vehicle collisions with bridges and elevated structures. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to supersede any other reporting requirements otherwise imposed upon the department by law, rule or regulation.

§ 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a law.
