

Assembly Resolution No. 226

AMENDING section 2 of Rule V of the Assembly Rules, in relation to ensuring that each member is entitled to have at least one substantive piece of legislation discharged from committee and brought to a vote during each two-year term

RESOLVED, That section 2 of Rule V of the Assembly Rules is amended by adding a new subdivision h to read as follows:

h. Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, during each two-year term of the Assembly, each member shall be entitled to have at least one substantive piece of legislation, of his or her choosing, exclusive of any bill accompanied by a home rule request, discharged from committee and brought to the floor for a vote on the merits. A member may bring such bill to the floor for a vote by filing a written notice with the index clerk of the Assembly on a form provided by such clerk.
