WHEREAS, Brianna Janicek and her friend then shipped a barrel filled with softball equipment for two teams, Team Brianna and Team Jessica, and raised funds to pay the coaches during the three-month period; the girls also sent self-made instructional videos on different aspects of the game; and

WHEREAS, Brianna Janicek is a credit to her family, her school, her community, her State and her Nation, and no doubt her future will be filled with accomplishments of equal importance; now, therefore, be it
