AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to including masking products within the definition of drug-related paraphernalia

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 850 of the general business law, as amended by chapter 433 of the laws of 2021, and  
2 subparagraph (vii) as separately amended by chapters 92 and 433 of the  
3 laws of 2021, is amended to read as follows:

4 (a) "Drug-related paraphernalia" consists of the following objects  
5 used for the following purposes:

6 (i) Kits, used or designed for the purpose of planting, propagating,  
7 cultivating, growing or harvesting of any species of plant which is a  
8 controlled substance or from which a controlled substance can be  
9 derived;

10 (ii) Kits, used or designed for the purpose of manufacturing,  
11 compounding, converting, producing, or preparing controlled substances;

12 (iii) Isomerization devices, used or designed for the purpose of  
13 increasing the potency of any species of plant which is a controlled  
14 substance;

15 (iv) Scales and balances, used or designed for the purpose of weighing  
16 or measuring controlled substances;

17 (v) Diluents and adulterants, including but not limited to quinine  
18 hydrochloride, mannitol, mannite, dextrose and lactose, used or designed  
19 for the purpose of cutting controlled substances;

20 (vi) ~~(vii)~~ and Objects, used or designed for the purpose of ingesting, inhal-  
21 ~~(vii)~~ and ing, or otherwise introducing cocaine into the human body; and

1     (vii) Masking products, including but not limited to synthetic urine,  
2 human urine, a substance used or designed to be added to human urine or  
3 a substance used or designed to be added to a chemical test, used for  
4 the purpose of defrauding a chemical test which is used to determine the  
5 alcoholic and/or drug content of the blood.

6     § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
