AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, in relation to authorizing the state board of law examiners to procure quarters for such board in the county of Albany

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 461 of the judiciary law, as added by chapter 649
2 of the laws of 1945, is amended to read as follows:
3 § 461. Compensation of state board of law examiners; appointment and
4 compensation of employees. The court of appeals shall fix the compensation of the members of the state board of law examiners appointed by
5 it as provided by section fifty-six of this chapter. The court of
6 appeals may provide and furnish proper and suitable quarters for said
7 board in the court of appeals hall or authorize it to procure the same
8 elsewhere in the [~~city~~] county of Albany; and may authorize said board
9 to appoint and remove a clerk, a stenographer and other necessary
10 employees whose compensation shall be fixed by the court. The compensation of members of said board, and of the clerk, stenographer and
11 other employees of the board shall be fixed within the amount annually
12 provided by appropriation. All such compensation and expenses shall be
13 paid after audit by and upon the warrant of the comptroller in the
14 manner provided by law.
15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
