AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to implementing automatic market rate increases for child care assistance

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 410-x of the social services law,
2 as added by section 52 of part B of chapter 436 of the laws of 1997, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 4. The amount to be paid [~~or allowed~~] for child care assistance funded
5 under the block grant shall be the [~~actual cost of care but no more than~~
6 ~~the applicable market-related~~] payment rate established by the depart-
7 ment in regulations, in accordance with the market-rate survey or an
8 approved alternative methodology. The payment rates established by the
9 department shall be sufficient to ensure equal access for eligible chil-
10 dren to comparable child care assistance in the substate area that are
11 provided to children whose parents are not eligible to receive assist-
12 ance under any federal or state programs. Such payment rates shall take
13 into account the variations in the costs of providing child care in
14 different settings and to children of different age groups, and the
15 additional costs of providing child care for children with special
16 needs.

17 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
