AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring persons with tinted windows lower such motor vehicle's tinted windows during a traffic stop

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 837-y
2 to read as follows:
3 § 837-y. Tinted windows during traffic stops. Where any officer has a
4 reasonable belief that the tinted windows of a motor vehicle during a
5 traffic stop pose a potential threat to the health or safety of such
6 officer, such officer may be allowed to require the driver of the motor
7 vehicle to lower all windows of the motor vehicle until such officer
8 determines there is no danger to such officer's health or safety. For
9 the purposes of this section, the term "tinted windows" shall mean
10 windows that have a light transmittance of less than seventy percent in
11 violation of subdivision twelve-a of section three hundred seventy-five
12 of the vehicle and traffic law.
13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
