Introduced by M. of A. K. BROWN -- read once and referred to the Committee on Transportation

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to establishing the felony of aggressive driving

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new
2 section 1212-a to read as follows:

3 § 1212-a. Aggressive driving. (a) Aggressive driving shall mean driv-
4 ing or using any motor vehicle and performing two or more of the follow-
5 ing actions: driving in violation of section eleven hundred ten of this
6 title; driving in violation of section eleven hundred twenty-six of this
7 title; driving in violation of section eleven hundred twenty-nine of
8 this title; driving in violation of section eleven hundred thirty of
9 this title; driving in violation of section eleven hundred thirty-one of
10 this title; driving in violation of section eleven hundred eighty of
11 this title by driving at a speed of more than twenty miles per hour over
12 the posted speed limit; suddenly and abruptly stopping or slowing the
13 vehicle while another vehicle is directly behind; or driving in a manner
14 which unreasonably interferes with the free and proper use of a public
15 highway.

16 (b) Every person convicted of violating this section shall be guilty
17 of a class E felony. Upon a conviction for a second violation of this
18 section, such person shall be guilty of a class D felony.

19 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
20 have become a law.
