AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to dedicating a portion of the state highway system in the village of Unionville as the "Appalachian Trail Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-r to
2 read as follows:
3 § 344-r. Portion of the state highway system to be dedicated as the
4 "Appalachian Trail Highway". All that portion of the state highway
5 system constituting state route 284 in the village of Unionville shall
6 be dedicated as the "Appalachian Trail Highway".
7 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-
8 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system
9 as dedicated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid
10 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the dedi-
11 cation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of
12 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be
13 changed as a result of this act.
14 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
