Cox served with distinction in the Nassau County Police Department for 30 years; rising to the rank of Detective in 2012, she served in the First and Seventh Squads, the Missing Persons Squad, and the Central Detective Squad, eventually concluding her decorated career as a Polygraph Detective; and

Cox is the visionary founder of "WOMEN ABLAZE" at her church; this ministry was birthed to promote unity, sisterhood, and the mandate for women to "Bloom where they are planted"; through monthly sessions, she provides the emotional support, spiritual guidance, and biblical truth necessary to help women transition from victims to victors; and
