WHEREAS, Knowing no bounds to community service, Dawn Snyder's philanthropic work also includes serving on the Executive Board of the Clarence Contemporary Club, which fosters civic pride and supports charitable and educational activities, and as the Event Coordinator for Fireworks in the Park; and

Dawn Snyder serves on the Staff-Pastor-Parish Relations Team; and
