AN ACT in relation to authorizing the discontinuance of certain parklands in the town of Amherst, county of Erie

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subject to the provisions of this act, the town of Amherst,
2 county of Erie, is hereby authorized, acting by and through its govern-
3 ing body, and upon such terms and conditions as determined by such
4 governing body, to discontinue as parklands and to lease at fair market
5 value to Bell Atlantic Mobile Systems, LLC d/b/a Verizon Wireless for a
6 term not to exceed thirty years the lands more particularly described in
7 section three of this act for the placement and operation of a wireless
8 communications tower.

9 § 2. The authorization contained in section one of this act shall only
10 be effective on the condition that the town of Amherst, county of Erie,
11 dedicate the proceeds from the lease towards the acquisition of new
12 parklands and/or capital improvements to existing park and recreational
13 facilities.

14 § 3. The parklands authorized by section one of this act to be discon-
15 tinued as parkland are described as follows:

16 All that tract or parcel of land situate in the Town of Amherst, Coun-
17 ty of Erie, State of New York, all as shown on a map entitled "Sworm-
18 ville Survey Plan", prepared by Costich Engineering, D.P.C., having
19 drawing number 8997, sheet number VA101, last dated 11/25/2024, and
20 being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

21 Commencing at a 0.75" pipe found on the assumed common line of lands
22 now or formerly owned by Charles Herberger (T.A.#28.04-1-52.11) to the
23 west and lands now or formerly owned by the Town of Amherst

51 owned by Kathleen Grimm (T.A.#28.04-1-53.112) a distance of 24.09 feet

22. Easterly along a curve to the left having a delta angle of 57°35'20", a radius of 71.00 feet, and an arc length of 71.36 feet, said curve also having a chord of N81°37'47"E 68.40 feet to a point; thence

23. N52°50'06"E, a distance of 72.46 feet to a point of curvature; thence

24. Northerly along a curve to the left having a delta angle of 29°38'29", a radius of 55.00 feet, and an arc length of 28.45 feet, said curve also having a chord of N38°00'52"E 28.14 feet to a point; thence

25. N23°11'38"E, a distance of 82.89 feet to a point of curvature; thence

26. Northerly along a curve to the right having a delta angle of 09°12'34", a radius of 101.00 feet, and an arc length of 16.23 feet, said curve also having a chord of N27°47'55"E 16.22 feet to a point; thence;

27. N47°10'44"W, a distance of 4.57 feet to a point being on the assumed common line of lands now or formerly owned by Charles Herberger (T.A.#28.04-1-52.11) to the west and lands now or formerly owned by the Town of Amherst (T.A.#28.04-1-45) to the east; thence

28. N23°11'38"E, along the assumed common line, a distance of 15.93 feet to the point and place of beginning. Containing 0.892 acres of land, more or less.

§ 4. Should the lands described in section three of this act cease to be used for the purposes described in section one of this act, the lease shall terminate and those lands shall revert to the town of Amherst for public park and recreational purposes. At the time of such reversion, the removal of such wireless communication tower shall take place and the property shall be returned to its previous state, consistent with park and recreational purposes.

§ 5. In the event that the town of Amherst received any funding support or assistance from the federal government for the purchase, maintenance, or improvement of the parklands set forth in section three of this act, the discontinuance and alienation of such parklands authorized by the provisions of this act shall not occur until the town of Amherst has complied with any federal requirements pertaining to the alienation or conversion of parklands, including satisfying the secretary of the interior that the alienation or conversion complies with all conditions which the secretary of the interior deems necessary to assure the substitution of other lands shall be equivalent in fair market value and usefulness to the lands being alienated or converted.

§ 6. This act shall take effect immediately.
