AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to authorizing consideration of non-economic loss suffered by consumers when determining penalties

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 25 of the public service law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 8 to read as follows:

3 8. In determining penalties pursuant to this section, including any
4 negotiated settlements between the commission and a public utility
5 company, corporation or person and the officers, agents and employees
6 thereof, the commission may consider non-economic loss suffered by
7 consumers including, but not limited to, pain and suffering or mental
8 anguish.

9 § 2. Section 25-a of the public service law is amended by adding a new
10 subdivision 12 to read as follows:

11 12. In determining penalties pursuant to this section, including any
12 negotiated settlements between the commission and a combination gas and
13 electric corporation or the officers thereof, the commission may consid-
14 er non-economic loss suffered by consumers, including but not limited
15 to, pain and suffering or mental anguish.

16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
