AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring a report on the utilization and activity of the statewide fiscal intermediary; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 365-f of the social services law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:

3 10. Report on the utilization and activity of the statewide fiscal
4 intermediary. (a) The commissioner of health shall produce a report on
5 the utilization and activity of the statewide fiscal intermediary. Such
6 report shall include, but not be limited to:

7 (i) the number of consumers enrolled in the consumer directed personal
8 assistance program (CDPAP) as of March thirty-first, two thousand twen-
9 ty-five;

10 (ii) the number of consumers enrolled with the new statewide fiscal
11 intermediary, Public Partnerships, LLC at the time such report is
12 published;

13 (iii) the number of consumers who did not enroll in the new statewide
14 fiscal intermediary, Public Partnerships, LLC; and

15 (iv) the modes of outreach and number of attempts to connect with the
16 consumers under subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph who did not enroll,
17 and where applicable, the reasons for denial whether it be no response,
18 incomplete application or ineligibility.

19 (b) The report shall also include an evaluation of the performance of
20 the program contractor or contractors and of the cost effectiveness of
21 all outreach efforts enrollment and program cost projections for the
22 next two fiscal years.

1 (c) The report shall be published on the department of health website
2 and delivered to the governor, the temporary president of the senate,
3 the speaker of the assembly, the minority leaders of each house, and the
4 members who sit on both the assembly committee on health and the senate
5 committee on health.

6 (d) The report under this subdivision shall be completed and published
7 no later than sixty days after the effective date of this subdivision.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be
9 deemed repealed one year after such effective date.
