AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to authorizing the office for the aging to establish, operate and maintain programs for transportation services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs (e) and (f) of subdivision 2 of section 203 of
2 the elder law are amended and a new paragraph (g) is added to read as
3 follows:

4 (e) operation of multi-service centers; [~~and~~]

5 (f) retired senior volunteer programs[~~-~~]; and

6 (g) transportation services.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
8 have become a law.
