AN ACT to amend the domestic relations law, in relation to certain orders during divorce proceedings

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 240 of the domestic relations law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 1-d to read as follows:

3 1-D. DURING THE PENDENCY OF ANY ACTION SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION THE COURT SHALL ISSUE AN ORDER PROHIBITING BOTH PARTIES 4 TO 5 LITIGATION FROM INTERFERING WITH THE OTHER PARTY'S THE PARENTAL 6 RELATIONSHIP. INTERFERENCE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, FAILURE 7 TO COMPLY WITH COURT ORDERS, EFFORTS TO ALIENATE THE CHILD FROM THE 8 OTHER PARTY, DISPARAGING REMARKS MADE ABOUT THE OTHER PARTY IN THE PRES-9 THE CHILD, AND GENERAL UNWILLINGNESS TO FOSTER A RELATIONSHIP ENCE OF 10 BETWEEN THE CHILD AND THE OTHER PARTY. THE COURT SHALL HAVE DISCRETION 11 ISSUING ORDERS UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION IN CASES OF ABUSE OR DOMESTIC IN12 VIOLENCE. ANY VIOLATION OF AN ORDER UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED CONTEMPT OF COURT. 13

14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
