AN ACT to amend the insurance law and the public health law, in relation
to coverage for the screening, diagnosis and treatment of autism spec-
trum disorder

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph 25 of subsection (i) of section 3216 of the
2 insurance law, as added by chapter 557 of the laws of 2006, is amended
3 to read as follows:
4 (25) Every policy which provides coverage for hospital, surgical, or
5 medical care coverage shall [not exclude] PROVIDE coverage for THE
6 SCREENING, diagnosis and treatment of [medical conditions otherwise
7 covered by the policy solely because the treatment is provided to diag-
8 nose or treat] autism spectrum disorder IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PARA-
9 GRAPH. SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES, COPAYMENTS
10 AND COINSURANCE AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AND
11 SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE IMPOSED ON OTHER BENEFITS UNDER THE POLI-
12 CY. THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS LIMITING THE BENEFITS THAT
13 ARE OTHERWISE AVAILABLE TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE POLICY. COVERAGE MAY
14 BE SUBJECT TO UTILIZATION REVIEW OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES, INCLUDING THE
15 REVIEW OF MEDICAL NECESSITY, CASE MANAGEMENT, AND OTHER MANAGED CARE
16 PROVISIONS.
17 (A) For purposes of this [section] PARAGRAPH, "autism spectrum disor-

25 SIONER OF THE OFFICE OF MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILI-
26 TIES, SHALL PROMULGATE, AND REGULARLY UPDATE, REGULATIONS WHICH SHALL
27 IDENTIFY TREATMENT AND THERAPY OPTIONS FOR WHICH COVERAGE SHALL BE
28 REQUIRED FOR THE SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF AUTISM SPECTRUM
29 DISORDER PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH. SUCH TREATMENT AND THERAPY OPTIONS
30 SHALL BE EVIDENCE-BASED, PEER-REVIEWED AND CLINICALLY PROVEN. UNTIL SUCH

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1 TIME AS REGULATIONS ARE PROMULGATED, THE CURRENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
2 PUBLISHED CLINICAL REPORTS AND TREATMENT GUIDELINES OF THE AMERICAN
3 ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS FOR THE SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF
4 AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER SHALL SERVE AS THE STANDARD OF TREATMENT AND
5 THERAPY OPTIONS TO BE COVERED PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH. COVERAGE FOR

12 OR AN INDIVIDUALIZED SERVICE PLAN PURSUANT TO REGULATIONS OF THE OFFICE
13 OF MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES. THE PROVISION OF
14 SERVICES PURSUANT TO AN INDIVIDUALIZED FAMILY SERVICE PLAN, AN INDIVID-
15 UALIZED EDUCATION PLAN OR AN INDIVIDUALIZED SERVICE PLAN SHALL NOT
16 AFFECT COVERAGE UNDER THE POLICY FOR SERVICES PROVIDED ON A SUPPLEMENTAL
17 BASIS OUTSIDE OF AN EDUCATIONAL SETTING IF SUCH SERVICES ARE DEEMED
18 MEDICALLY NECESSARY.

19 (C) THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO AFFECT ANY OBLIGATION TO

31 S 2. Paragraph 17 of subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance

36 DELIVERED OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY IN THIS STATE which provides coverage

38 PROVIDE coverage for THE SCREENING, diagnosis and treatment of [medical
39 conditions otherwise covered by the policy because the treatment is
40 provided to diagnose or treat] autism spectrum disorder IN ACCORDANCE
41 WITH THIS PARAGRAPH. SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES,
42 COPAYMENTS AND COINSURANCE AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPER-
43 INTENDENT AND SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE IMPOSED ON OTHER BENEFITS

34 SHALL MEET CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION, INCLUDING PROVIDER
35 CREDENTIALING. THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH SHALL ENSURE THAT PROVIDER
36 NETWORKS ARE ADEQUATE TO IMPLEMENT THIS PARAGRAPH.

37 S 3. Subsection (ee) of section 4303 of the insurance law, as added by
38 chapter 557 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

39 (ee) A medical expense indemnity corporation, a hospital service
40 corporation or a health service corporation which provides coverage for
41 hospital, surgical, or medical care coverage shall [not exclude] PROVIDE
42 coverage for THE SCREENING, diagnosis and treatment of [medical condi-
43 tions otherwise covered by the policy solely because the treatment is
44 provided to diagnose or treat] autism spectrum disorder IN ACCORDANCE
45 WITH THIS SUBSECTION. SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCT-
46 IBLES, COPAYMENTS AND COINSURANCE AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE
47 SUPERINTENDENT AND SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE IMPOSED ON OTHER BENE-
48 FITS UNDER THE CONTRACT. THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS

29 (3) THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO AFFECT ANY OBLIGATION TO
30 PROVIDE SERVICES TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER AN INDIVIDUALIZED FAMILY SERVICE
31 PLAN UNDER SECTION TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE OF THE PUBLIC
32 HEALTH LAW, AN INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PLAN UNDER ARTICLE EIGHTY-NINE
33 OF THE EDUCATION LAW OR AN INDIVIDUALIZED SERVICE PLAN PURSUANT TO REGU-
34 LATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILI-
35 TIES.

36 (4) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PREVENT A
37 CONTRACT FROM PROVIDING SERVICES THROUGH A NETWORK OF PARTICIPATING
38 PROVIDERS WHO SHALL MEET CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION, INCLUD-
39 ING PROVIDER CREDENTIALING. THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH SHALL ENSURE
40 THAT PROVIDER NETWORKS ARE ADEQUATE TO IMPLEMENT THIS PARAGRAPH.

41 S 4. Section 2500-j of the public health law is amended by adding a
42 new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

43 4. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT OF INSUR-
44 ANCE, THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH AND THE COMMIS-
45 SIONER OF THE OFFICE OF MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILI-
46 TIES, SHALL PROMULGATE, AND REGULARLY UPDATE, REGULATIONS WHICH SHALL
47 IDENTIFY TREATMENT AND THERAPY OPTIONS FOR WHICH COVERAGE SHALL BE
48 REQUIRED FOR THE SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF AUTISM SPECTRUM
49 DISORDER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS THIRTY-TWO HUNDRED SIXTEEN, THIRTY-TWO
50 HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE AND FORTY-THREE HUNDRED THREE OF THE INSURANCE LAW.

51 S 5. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
52 ing the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to all
53 policies or contracts issued, renewed, modified, altered or amended on
54 and after such effective date.
