Introduced by M. of A. MORELLE, SILVER, WEISENBERG, NOLAN, ORTIZ, SCHROEDER -- read once and referred to the Committee on Insurance

AN ACT to amend the insurance law and the public health law, in relation to coverage for the screening, diagnosis and treatment of autism spectrum disorder

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph 25 of subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law, as added by chapter 557 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

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- (25) Every policy which provides coverage for hospital, surgical, or medical care coverage shall [not exclude] PROVIDE coverage for THE SCREENING, diagnosis and treatment of [medical conditions otherwise covered by the policy solely because the treatment is provided to diagnose or treat] autism spectrum disorder IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PARAGRAPH. SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES, COPAYMENTS AND COINSURANCE AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AND SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE IMPOSED ON OTHER BENEFITS UNDER THE POLICY. THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS LIMITING THE BENEFITS THAT ARE OTHERWISE AVAILABLE TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE POLICY. COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO UTILIZATION REVIEW OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES, INCLUDING THE REVIEW OF MEDICAL NECESSITY, CASE MANAGEMENT, AND OTHER MANAGED CARE PROVISIONS.

SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES, COPAYMENTS AND COINSURANCE AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPER-INTENDENT AND SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE IMPOSED ON OTHER BENEFITS THE POLICY. THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH SHALL ENSURE THAT PROVIDER NETWORKS ARE ADEQUATE TO IMPLEMENT THIS PARAGRAPH.
  - S 4. Section 2500-j of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
  - 4. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT OF INSURANCE, THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH AND THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, SHALL PROMULGATE, AND REGULARLY UPDATE, REGULATIONS WHICH SHALL IDENTIFY TREATMENT AND THERAPY OPTIONS FOR WHICH COVERAGE SHALL BE REQUIRED FOR THE SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS THIRTY-TWO HUNDRED SIXTEEN, THIRTY-TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE AND FORTY-THREE HUNDRED THREE OF THE INSURANCE LAW.
- S 5. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to all policies or contracts issued, renewed, modified, altered or amended on and after such effective date.
