AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to remote metering by farm service and non-residential customer-generators

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 66-1 of the public service law is
2 amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:
3 (E) A FARM SERVICE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR AS DEFINED BY PARAGRAPH (C) OF
4 SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION OR A NON-RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER-GENERATOR
5 AS DEFINED BY PARAGRAPH (C-1) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION MAY
6 LOCATE WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING EQUIPMENT WITH A NET ENERGY METER ON
7 LAND OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR AND DESIGNATE ONE
8 HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE NET METERING CREDITS GENERATED BY SUCH EQUIPMENT
9 TO A METER OR METERS OWNED BY THE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR AT ANY LOCATION
10 OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR WITHIN THE SERVICE AREA OF
11 THE SAME ELECTRIC CORPORATION TO WHICH THE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR'S NET
12 ENERGY METERS ARE INTERCONNECTED AND BEING WITHIN A RADIUS OF
13 TWENTY-FIVE MILES OF THE WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING EQUIPMENT.
14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
