AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to student activity fees

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 355 of the education law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 20 to read as follows:

3 20. STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE. A. DISCLOSURE. EVERY COLLEGE OR UNIVERSI-4 TY OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY SHALL CONSPICUOUSLY POST ON A PUBLICLY ACCES-SIBLE WEBSITE A NOTICE REGARDING THE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE WHICH SHALL 5 6 INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO: (1) THE PURPOSE OF SUCH FEE, (2) THE 7 RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM SUCH FEE, (3) THE MISSION STATEMENT OF EACH STUDENT ORGANIZATION THAT RECEIVED 8 NAME AND 9 FUNDING FROM SUCH FEE DURING THE PREVIOUS ACADEMIC YEAR, (4) THE 10 ALL FUNDING DECISIONS BE MADE IN AN OPEN FORUM WHERE REOUIREMENT THAT 11 ALL STUDENTS ARE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT, (5) THAT ALL FUNDING DECISIONS SHALL BE MADE IN A FAIR AND NEUTRAL MANNER WITHOUT REGARD TO 12 THE VIEWPOINTS OF THE ORGANIZATION REQUESTING FUNDING, AND (6) THAT A 13 14 REFERENDUM SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST EVERY TWO YEARS THE PURPOSE OF WHICH IS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE SHALL BE MANDATORY 15 OR 16 VOLUNTARY.

THE CLOSE OF THE FIRST FULL ACADEMIC YEAR 17 в. REFERENDUM. PRIOR TO IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION, AND AT 18 19 LEAST ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS THEREAFTER, THE STUDENT BODY AT EACH COLLEGE 20 OR UNIVERSITY OPERATED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY SHALL DETERMINE BY REFER-21 ENDUM WHETHER STUDENT ACTIVITY PROGRAMS SHALL BE SUPPORTED BY EITHER 22 VOLUNTARY OR MANDATORY STUDENT FEES. SUCH REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONDUCTED 23 CAMPUS AT AN EASILY ACCESSIBLE POLLING PLACE OR PLACES AND AT SUCH ON TIME AS SHALL BE CONVENIENT FOR THE GREATEST NUMBER OF STUDENTS. 24 UNDER 25 NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL FUNDING FOR ANY PARTICULAR ORGANIZATION BE DETER-26 MINED BY REFERENDUM. NOTICE OF SUCH REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONSPICUOUSLY 27 POSTED AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS ON CAMPUS FOR NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN DAYS 28 PRIOR TO THE DATE ON WHICH THE REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONDUCTED. SUCH

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1 NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE DATE ON WHICH THE 2 REFERENDUM WILL BE HELD, THE TIMES DURING WHICH POLLING PLACES WILL BE 3 OPEN, THE LOCATION OF ALL POLLING PLACES, AND THE QUESTION OR QUESTIONS 4 BEFORE THE STUDENT BODY.

5 C. ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING. ANY GROUP THAT IS OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED BY 6 THE REPRESENTATIVE STUDENT ORGANIZATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES 7 ESTABLISHED ON EACH CAMPUS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FUNDING FROM 8 STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE PROCEEDS.

9 D. DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS. PROCEEDS OF THE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE SHALL 10 BE DISBURSED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE STUDENT ORGANIZATION IN A FAIR AND 11 NEUTRAL MANNER WITHOUT REGARD TO THE VIEWPOINTS OF THE ORGANIZATION 12 REQUESTING FUNDING. ALL FUNDING DECISIONS SHALL BE MADE IN AN OPEN FORUM 13 WHERE MEMBERS OF THE STUDENT BODY ARE GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT.

E. APPEAL OF FUNDING DECISIONS. THE REPRESENTATIVE STUDENT ORGANIZATION ON EACH CAMPUS SHALL CREATE AN APPEALS PROCESS FOR REGISTERED
STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS COMPLAINING OF VIEWPOINT DISCRIMINATION IN THE
FUNDING PROCESS. AFTER EXHAUSTING STUDENT REVIEW, AN AGGRIEVED REGISTERED STUDENT ORGANIZATION MAY APPEAL TO THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF EACH CAMPUS, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE.

20 S 2. Section 6215 of the education law is amended by adding a new 21 subdivision 4 to read as follows:

22 4. STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE. A. DISCLOSURE. EVERY COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OF THE CITY UNIVERSITY SHALL CONSPICUOUSLY POST ON A PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE 23 WEBSITE A NOTICE REGARDING THE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, 24 25 NOT BE LIMITED TO: (1) THE PURPOSE OF SUCH FEE, (2) THE RULES AND BUT PROCEDURES FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM SUCH FEE, (3) THE NAME AND 26 27 MISSION STATEMENT OF EACH STUDENT ORGANIZATION THAT RECEIVED FUNDING 28 FROM SUCH FEE DURING THE PREVIOUS ACADEMIC YEAR, (4) THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL FUNDING DECISIONS BE MADE IN AN OPEN FORUM WHERE ALL STUDENTS 29 ARE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT, (5) THAT ALL FUNDING DECISIONS 30 SHALL BE MADE IN A FAIR AND NEUTRAL MANNER WITHOUT REGARD TO THE VIEW-31 32 POINTS OF THE ORGANIZATION REQUESTING FUNDING, AND (6) THAT A REFERENDUM SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST EVERY TWO YEARS THE PURPOSE OF WHICH IS TO DETER-33 MINE WHETHER THE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE SHALL BE MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY. 34

SUCH REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONDUCTED ON CAMPUS AT AN EASILY ACCESSIBLE POLLING PLACE OR PLACES AND AT SUCH 41 TIME AS SHALL BE CONVENIENT FOR THE GREATEST NUMBER OF STUDENTS. UNDER 42 43 NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL FUNDING FOR ANY PARTICULAR ORGANIZATION BE DETER-MINED BY REFERENDUM. NOTICE OF SUCH REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONSPICUOUSLY 44 45 POSTED AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS ON CAMPUS FOR NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE ON WHICH THE REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONDUCTED. SUCH 46 47 NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE DATE ON WHICH THE REFERENDUM WILL BE HELD, THE TIMES DURING WHICH POLLING PLACES WILL BE 48 49 OPEN, THE LOCATION OF ALL POLLING PLACES, AND THE QUESTION OR QUESTIONS 50 BEFORE THE STUDENT BODY.

ESTABLISHED ON EACH CAMPUS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FUNDING FROM
STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE PROCEEDS.

SHALL CONSPICUOUSLY POST ON A PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE WEBSITE A NOTICE 13 14 REGARDING THE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO: (1) THE PURPOSE OF SUCH FEE, (2) THE RULES AND PROCEDURES 15 FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM SUCH FEE, (3) THE NAME AND MISSION 16 STATEMENT OF EACH STUDENT ORGANIZATION THAT RECEIVED FUNDING FROM SUCH 17 FEE DURING THE PREVIOUS ACADEMIC YEAR, (4) THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL 18 19 FUNDING DECISIONS BE MADE IN AN OPEN FORUM WHERE ALL STUDENTS ARE GIVEN 20 THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT, (5) THAT ALL FUNDING DECISIONS SHALL BE MADE 21 IN A FAIR AND NEUTRAL MANNER WITHOUT REGARD TO THE VIEWPOINTS OF THE ORGANIZATION REQUESTING FUNDING, AND (6) THAT A REFERENDUM SHALL BE HELD 22 AT LEAST EVERY TWO YEARS THE PURPOSE OF WHICH IS TO DETERMINE WHETHER 23 THE STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE SHALL BE MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY. 24

SUCH REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONDUCTED ON CAMPUS AT AN EASILY ACCESSI-BLE POLLING PLACE OR PLACES AND AT SUCH TIME AS SHALL BE CONVENIENT FOR 31 THE GREATEST NUMBER OF STUDENTS. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL FUNDING 32 33 FOR ANY PARTICULAR ORGANIZATION BE DETERMINED BY REFERENDUM. NOTICE OF SUCH REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS ON 34 35 CAMPUS FOR NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE ON WHICH THE REFERENDUM SHALL BE CONDUCTED. SUCH NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE 36 LIMITED TO, THE DATE ON WHICH THE REFERENDUM WILL BE HELD, THE TIMES 37 DURING WHICH POLLING PLACES WILL BE OPEN, THE LOCATION OF ALL POLLING 38 PLACES, AND THE QUESTION OR QUESTIONS BEFORE THE STUDENT BODY. 39

55 S 4. This act shall take effect on the first of August next succeeding 56 the date on which it shall have become a law.
