AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the duties of the commissioner of education with regard to early childhood education

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 42 to read as follows:

3 42. A. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES AND THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE, OR THEIR DESIGNEES, SHALL EXAMINE, EVALUATE, AND 6 7 MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING THE EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF CHIL-DREN FROM BIRTH THROUGH FIVE YEARS OF AGE. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL IDEN-TIFY, REVIEW, ANALYZE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ABOUT 9 STATE LAWS 10 PROGRAMS AND SERVICES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE REGULATIONS, FOLLOWING: REOUIREMENTS FOR THE EDUCATION OF CHILDREN FROM BIRTH THROUGH 11 FIVE YEARS OF AGE AT ALL SETTINGS WHICH CARE FOR SUCH CHILDREN INCLUDING 12 BUT NOT LIMITED TO PUBLIC AND NON-PUBLIC SCHOOLS, PRE-KINDERGARTEN 13 14 PROGRAMS, DAY CARE CENTERS AND FAMILY DAY CARE, EARLY INTERVENTION SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND 15 PROGRAMS, OTHER RELEVANT 16 REOUIREMENTS FOR DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES NECESSARY TO THE EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF CHILDREN FROM BIRTH THROUGH FIVE YEARS OF 17 AGE AT SETTINGS; THE HEALTH, FAMILY SUPPORT AND OTHER SERVICES NECESSARY FOR 18 19 THE EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF CHILDREN FROM BIRTH THROUGH FIVE 20 AGE; REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EDUCATION, CERTIFICATION AND TRAINING OF 21 PERSONNEL IN SUCH SETTINGS WHO ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR EDUCATION, 22 MENTAL SERVICES AND SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN FROM BIRTH THROUGH FIVE YEARS OF AGE INCLUDING TEACHERS, TEACHER ASSISTANTS AND DAY CARE PROVID-23 ERS, DIRECTORS AND EMPLOYEES; AND THE FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL FUNDING 24 FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AT PUBLIC AND NON-PUBLIC SCHOOLS, 25

B. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT ITS FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMEN-DATIONS WITHIN EIGHT MONTHS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION TO THE GOVERNOR, THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY COMMITTEES ON EDUCATION, 5 THE CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY COMMITTEES ON CHILDREN AND FAMI-LIES, THE CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY COMMITTEES ON SOCIAL 7 SERVICES AND THE CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY COMMITTEES ON HEALTH. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR STRENGTHENING ACCESS TO AND 8 THE QUALITY OF EDUCATIONAL, DEVELOPMENTAL AND FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS 9 10 AND SERVICES AT ALL SETTINGS WHERE SUCH PROGRAMS AND SERVICES ARE PROVIDED TO CHILDREN FROM BIRTH THROUGH FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND THE 11 CONSOLIDATION OF FUNDING, OVERSIGHT AND ENFORCEMENT FOR SUCH PROGRAMS 12 13 AND SERVICES.

14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
