Introduced by M. of A. ROSENTHAL -- (at request of the Governor) -- read once and referred to the Committee on Energy

AN ACT to amend the energy law, in relation to appliance and equipment energy efficiency standards for portable light fixtures, bottle-type water dispensers, commercial hot food holding cabinets, portable electric spas and residential pool pumps

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 16-102 of the energy law is amended by adding seven 2 new subdivisions 4-a, 6-a, 21-a, 21-b, 27-a, 27-b and 29-a to read as 3 follows:

4 4-A. "BOTTLE-TYPE WATER DISPENSER" MEANS A WATER DISPENSER THAT USES A 5 BOTTLE OR RESERVOIR AS THE SOURCE OF POTABLE WATER.

6 6-A. "COMMERCIAL HOT FOOD HOLDING CABINET" MEANS A HEATED, FULLY ENCLOSED COMPARTMENT, WITH ONE OR MORE SOLID OR 7 PARTIAL GLASS DOORS, 8 IS DESIGNED TO MAINTAIN THE TEMPERATURE OF HOT FOOD THAT HAS BEEN THAT 9 COOKED IN A SEPARATE APPLIANCE. "COMMERCIAL HOT FOOD HOLDING CABINET" DOES NOT INCLUDE HEATED GLASS MERCHANDISING CABINETS, DRAWER WARMERS OR 10 COOK-AND-HOLD APPLIANCES. 11

12 21-A. "LAMP" MEANS AN ELECTRICAL APPLIANCE THAT INCLUDES A GLASS 13 ENVELOPE AND PRODUCES OPTICAL RADIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF VISUAL ILLU-14 MINATION, DESIGNED TO BE INSTALLED INTO A LIGHT FIXTURE BY MEANS OF AN 15 INTEGRAL LAMP-HOLDER OR SOCKET.

16 21-B. "LIGHT FIXTURE" MEANS A PRODUCT DESIGNED TO PROVIDE LIGHT THAT 17 INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE LAMP-HOLDER OR SOCKET AND PARTS TO DISTRIBUTE THE 18 LIGHT, TO POSITION OR PROTECT ONE OR MORE LAMPS AND TO CONNECT ONE OR 19 MORE LAMPS TO A POWER SUPPLY.

20 27-A. "PORTABLE ELECTRIC SPA" MEANS A FACTORY-BUILT ELECTRIC SPA OR 21 HOT TUB, SUPPLIED WITH EQUIPMENT FOR HEATING AND CIRCULATING WATER.

27-B. "PORTABLE LIGHT FIXTURE" MEANS A LIGHT FIXTURE WHICH HAS A FLEXIBLE CORD AND AN ATTACHMENT PLUG FOR CONNECTION TO A NOMINAL ONE HUNDRED
TWENTY-VOLT, FIFTEEN- OR TWENTY-AMPERE BRANCH CIRCUIT; WHICH CAN BE
RELOCATED BY THE USER WITHOUT ANY REWIRING; AND WHICH IS TYPICALLY
CONTROLLED WITH A SWITCH LOCATED ON THE LIGHT FIXTURE ITSELF OR ON THE

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POWER CORD. "PORTABLE LIGHT FIXTURE" DOES NOT INCLUDE DIRECT PLUG-IN 1 2 NIGHTLIGHTS; SUN AND HEAT LAMPS; AQUARIUM LAMPS; MEDICAL AND DENTAL 3 LIGHTS; PORTABLE ELECTRIC HAND LAMPS; SIGNS AND COMMERCIAL ADVERTISING 4 DISPLAYS; PHOTOGRAPHIC LAMPS; GERMICIDAL LAMPS; METAL HALIDE LAMP 5 FIXTURES; TORCHIERE LIGHTING FIXTURES; PORTABLE LAMP FIXTURES FOR MARINE 6 USE OR FOR USE IN HAZARDOUS LOCATIONS AS DEFINED IN THE NATIONAL ELEC-7 TRICAL CODE, ANSI/NFPA 70; OR DECORATIVE LIGHTING OUTFITS OR ELECTRIC 8 CANDLES AND CANDELABRAS WITHOUT LAMPSHADES THAT ARE COVERED BY THE STAN-DARD FOR SAFETY OF SEASONAL AND HOLIDAY DECORATIVE PRODUCTS, UL 588. 9

10 29-A. "RESIDENTIAL POOL PUMP" MEANS A PRODUCT WHICH IS DESIGNED OR 11 USED TO CIRCULATE AND FILTER RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOL WATER IN ORDER TO 12 MAINTAIN CLARITY AND SANITATION AND WHICH CONSISTS IN PART OF A MOTOR 13 AND AN IMPELLER.

14 S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 16-104 of the energy law, as added by 15 chapter 431 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows:

16 1. The provisions of this article apply to the testing, certification 17 and enforcement of efficiency standards for the following new products which are sold, offered for sale or installed in New York state: (a) 18 automatic commercial ice cube machines; (b) ceiling fan light kits; (c) commercial pre-rinse spray valves; (d) commercial refrigerators, freez-19 20 21 ers and refrigerator-freezers; (e) consumer audio and video products; 22 illuminated exit signs; (g) incandescent reflector lamps; (h) very (f) 23 large commercial packaged air-conditioning and heating equipment; (i) metal halide lamp fixtures; (j) pedestrian traffic signal modules; (k) 24 25 power supplies; (1) torchiere lighting fixtures; (m) unit heaters [and] 26 (n) vehicular traffic signal modules; (0) PORTABLE LIGHT FIXTURES; (P) 27 BOTTLE-TYPE WATER DISPENSERS; (Q) COMMERCIAL HOT FOOD HOLDING CABINETS; 28 (R) PORTABLE ELECTRIC SPAS; AND (S) RESIDENTIAL POOL PUMPS.

29 S 3. Subdivision 2 of section 16-106 of the energy law is amended by 30 adding a new paragraph (c) to read as follows:

(C) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TEN, THE 31 SECRE-IN CONSULTATION WITH THE PRESIDENT, SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS IN 32 TARY, 33 ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE ESTABLISHING: (I) ENERGY 34 EFFICIENCY PERFORMANCE STANDARDS FOR NEW PRODUCTS OF THE TYPES SET FORTH 35 PARAGRAPHS (O) THROUGH (S) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION 16-104 OF IN THIS ARTICLE; (II) PROCEDURES FOR TESTING THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY OF 36 THE 37 PRODUCTS COVERED BY PARAGRAPHS (O) THROUGH (S) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF 38 SECTION 16-104 OF THIS ARTICLE; (III) PROCEDURES FOR MANUFACTURERS ТО CERTIFY THAT PRODUCTS COVERED BY PARAGRAPHS (O) THROUGH (S) OF SUBDIVI-39 40 SION ONE OF SECTION 16-104 OF THIS ARTICLE MEET THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ARTICLE; AND (IV) SUCH FURTHER MATTERS 41 AS ARE NECESSARY TO INSURE THE PROPER IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF 42 43 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE WITH RESPECT TO THE PRODUCTS COVERED BY 44 PARAGRAPHS (O) THROUGH (S) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION 16-104 OF THIS 45 ARTICLE.
