Introduced by M. of A. DINOWITZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Insurance

ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to reimbursement for testing for familial dysautonomia, Canavan's disease and Tay-Sachs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph 26 to read as follows:
 - (26) (A) EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR HOSPITAL, LABORATORY TESTS OR OR MEDICAL CARE OR PROVIDES REIMBURSEMENT FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR DIAGNOSTIC X-RAY SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR TESTING FOR FAMILIAL DYSAUTONOMIA, CANAVAN'S DISEASE AND TAY-SACHS.

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- SUCH COVERAGE SHALL BE INCLUDED AT THE INCEPTION OF ALL NEW POLI-CIES AND, WITH RESPECT TO ALL OTHER POLICIES, AT ANY ANNIVERSARY DATE OF THE POLICY SUBJECT TO EVIDENCE OF INSURABILITY.
- 10 (C) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE CONFIDEN-TIALITY OF PERSONS TESTED, RECEIPT OF AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT FROM THE LABORA-TORY PERFORMING THE TEST FOR FAMILIAL DYSAUTONOMIA, CANAVAN'S DISEASE TAY-SACHS SHALL BE DEEMED SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE OF THE PERFORMANCE OF SUCH TESTING.
 - (D) SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES AND DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AND AS ARE RANCE AS MAY BE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE ESTABLISHED FOR OTHER BENEFITS WITHIN Α POLICY.
- S 2. Subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by 19 20 adding a new paragraph 18 to read as follows:
- 21 (18) (A) A GROUP POLICY WHICH PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR HOSPITAL, SURGICAL 22 CARE OR PROVIDES REIMBURSEMENT FOR LABORATORY TESTS OR 23 REIMBURSEMENT FOR DIAGNOSTIC X-RAY SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR TESTING FOR FAMILIAL DYSAUTONOMIA, CANAVAN'S DISEASE AND TAY-SACHS.

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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(B) SUCH COVERAGE SHALL BE INCLUDED AT THE INCEPTION OF ALL NEW POLI-CIES AND, WITH RESPECT TO ALL OTHER POLICIES, AT ANY ANNIVERSARY DATE OF THE POLICY SUBJECT TO EVIDENCE OF INSURABILITY.

- (C) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE CONFIDEN-TIALITY OF PERSONS TESTED, RECEIPT OF AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT FROM THE LABORA-TORY PERFORMING THE TEST FOR FAMILIAL DYSAUTONOMIA, CANAVAN'S DISEASE AND TAY-SACHS SHALL BE DEEMED SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE OF THE PERFORMANCE OF SUCH TESTING.
- (D) SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES AND CO-INSU-9 10 RANCE AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AND AS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THOSE ESTABLISHED FOR OTHER BENEFITS WITHIN A GIVEN 11 12 POLICY.
 - S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (ff) to read as follows:
 - (FF) (1) A MEDICAL EXPENSE INDEMNITY CORPORATION, A HOSPITAL SERVICE CORPORATION OR A HEALTH SERVICE CORPORATION WHICH PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR HOSPITAL, SURGICAL OR MEDICAL CARE OR PROVIDES REIMBURSEMENT FOR LABORA-TORY TESTS OR REIMBURSEMENT FOR DIAGNOSTIC X-RAY SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR TESTING FOR FAMILIAL DYSAUTONOMIA, CANAVAN'S DISEASE TAY-SACHS.
 - (2) SUCH COVERAGE SHALL BE INCLUDED AT THE INCEPTION OF ALL NEW POLI-CIES AND, WITH RESPECT TO ALL OTHER POLICIES, AT ANY ANNIVERSARY DATE OF THE POLICY SUBJECT TO EVIDENCE OF INSURABILITY.
- 24 (3) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE CONFI-DENTIALITY OF PERSONS TESTED, RECEIPT OF AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT FROM THE 26 LABORATORY PERFORMING THE TEST FOR FAMILIAL DYSAUTONOMIA, CANAVAN'S 27 DISEASE AND TAY-SACHS SHALL BE DEEMED SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE OF THE PERFORMANCE OF SUCH TESTING.
- (4) SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES AND CO-INSU-29 RANCE AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AND AS ARE 30 CONSISTENT WITH THOSE ESTABLISHED FOR OTHER BENEFITS WITHIN A GIVEN 31 32 POLICY.
- S 4. This act shall take effect immediately. 33
