AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to granting tenants, with a physically disabling condition that affects their mobility, a preference in occupying a vacant dwelling unit on a lower floor in the same building in projects operated by the New York city housing authority

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 402 of the public housing law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 5 SUCH VACANT DWELLING UNIT SHALL FIRST BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR OCCUPANCY TO
- 6 ANY TENANT WITHIN THE SAME BUILDING WHO LIVES ON A HIGHER FLOOR THAN THE
- 7 VACANT DWELLING UNIT, WHEN THE VACANT DWELLING UNIT IS THE SAME SIZE OR
- 8 SMALLER THAN THE UNIT OCCUPIED BY SUCH TENANT, AND WHO HAS OR HAS A
- 9 FAMILY MEMBER RESIDING WITH HIM OR HER, WHO HAS A PHYSICALLY DISABLING
- 10 CONDITION THAT AFFECTS MOBILITY.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
