AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to enacting the "bad loan escape act"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "bad loan 2 escape act".
- 3 S 2. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 253-x to read as 4 follows:

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- S 253-X. EXEMPT MUNICIPAL MORTGAGE TAX FOR REFINANCES. 1. EVERY MUNICIPALITY WHICH HAS ENACTED A LOCAL MORTGAGE TAX OR RECORDING TAX PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL GRANT AN EXEMPTION UP TO THE AMOUNT OF THE ORIGINAL MORTGAGE FROM SUCH TAX WHERE THE MORTGAGOR IS REFINANCING HIS OR HER REAL PROPERTY.
- 2. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE NECESSARY AND ADVISABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH GROUNDS FOR QUALIFICATIONS, PROOF AND PROCEDURE NECESSARY FOR A MORTGAGOR TO OBTAIN SUCH EXEMPTION.
- 13 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 14 effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule 15 or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effec-16 tive date are authorized and directed to be made and completed on or 17 before such effective date.
