AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to establishing a contract for the employment of domestic workers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 201-g to 2 read as follows:

3 S 201-G. DOMESTIC WORKER CONTRACTS. 1. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ESTAB-4 LISH THE FORM AND CONTENT OF CONTRACTS FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF DOMESTIC 5 WORKERS. EVERY SUCH CONTRACT SHALL INCLUDE:

6 A. A DESCRIPTION OF THE EMPLOYMENT AND THE DUTIES THAT ARE EXPECTED TO 7 BE PERFORMED IN THE COURSE OF SUCH EMPLOYMENT;

B. THE EXPECTED NUMBER OF HOURS OF WORK PER WEEK;

C. PROVISIONS FOR VACATION, HOLIDAY, PERSONAL AND SICK LEAVE;

D. THE RATE OF WAGES PAID FOR SUCH EMPLOYMENT; AND

11 E. CONSENT TO WORK OVERTIME.

12 2. NO PERSON SHALL EMPLOY ANY DOMESTIC WORKER UNLESS SUCH PERSON HAS 13 ENTERED INTO A WRITTEN CONTRACT, MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBDIVISION 14 ONE OF THIS SECTION, WITH EACH DOMESTIC WORKER EMPLOYED.

15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that subdivision 16 2 of section 201-g of the labor law, as added by section one of this 17 act, shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
