AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to preparation of environmental impact statements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 8-0109 of the environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 10. AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT SHALL BE PREPARED FOR ANY STATE OR URBAN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY HOUSING COMMUNITY OR EDUCATIONAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT. SUCH STATEMENT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE MOST DETAILED ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT REQUIRED BY THIS ARTICLE OR BY ANY SUCH RULE OR REGULATION PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
